Father Mike’s Musings

On the weekend of July 21st and 22nd, I had somewhat nervously preached about the beautiful vision of marital love expressed by Blessed Pope Paul VI. July 25, 2018 had marked the 50th Anniversary of *Humanae Vitae*, and I see a strong connection between this famous (perhaps “infamous”) encyclical to some and a comprehensive pre-marriage preparation program “Remain In My Love” which will be “rolled out” to the parishes in early 2019.

Marriage, a civil contract AND a sacrament when celebrated by two Christians, “is far from being the effect of chance or the result of the blind evolution of natural farces. It is in reality the wise and provident institution of God the Creator whose purpose was to effect in man His loving design” (HV#8). Marriage is therefore “good” and has goods: fidelity, permanence and openness to new life. I have recently given brochures about *Humanae Vitae* to Deacon Bob, who will include them in the materials for our parish premarriage preparation program, since Blessed Pope Paul VI’s encyclical shows the beautiful role which the goods of marriage play in understanding its awesome place in society. I have recently been meeting with engaged couples from our parish to specifically have a conversation about what fidelity, permanence and openness to new life means to them.

For your own self study, please feel free to take a copy of the brochures for the 50th Anniversary of *Humanae Vitae* from the bookcase. God is good all the time, and so is marriage! Married couples: Thank you for your commitment to your vocation. Please do not be afraid to allow the grace of the sacrament to enable you to be mentors for engaged couples. Engaged couples: Learn from the wisdom of committed married couples.

Expectant and New Parents

Registration for your child's Baptism should be part of the plans for your baby's arrival. Just call the rectory, 215-357-1221, to begin the process. Life will only get busier once your little one arrives.

If you have already been blessed with a new little one and you haven't registered for the Baptism program, just call. You will be sent a letter with information about the process. For whatever reason, if your child is older and has never been baptized, guess what, just call.

Once you receive the letter, call to schedule the parent interview which should take place before the 'Meet and Greet' with other couples and members of the Baptism team.

Celebration of the sacrament is every 1st and 3rd Sunday throughout the year.

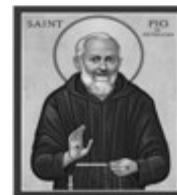
Golf Outing at the Bensalem Country Club
