Isaiah 45: 1, 4-6; Ps. 96; 1 Thessalonians 1: 1-5b; Matthew 22: 15-21

"The Pharisees went off and plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech". If Jesus walked the streets of Feasterville or Washington, DC today I suspect a biographer would write the same thing today. Depending on the issue or law to be passed, the underlined word could have many substitutes. However, we know that no group or person would ever entrap Jesus!

What question might replace, vs. 17 in today's Gospel, "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar?" Or should we just respond to the answer "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." The government will surely tell me what I owe. But God just waits for me to discover how blessed I am, recognize the origin of my gifts and talents and then respond by using my gifts to serve God's people. Often we do use our gifts of wisdom, courage, kindness in service to those we work with, or our neighbors, or others we meet in various ways on our life journey. Parents have a critical job to role model service to those in need for their children. This may include persons we differ with but whose current difficult situation we can help alleviate. Assumption parish is so blessed with selfless volunteers who are giving back to God what has been given to them.

Then there are times when we have the gifts but selfishly make a decision to do it later or next week because a relative or neighbor's need breaks into "me" time. Me time can be a football game, TV show or not wanting to go out of my way right now.

This week let us ponder the enormous number of gifts we have, from a sunny smile to lift one's spirits, a listening ear to hear yet again a relative's tragedy, to the skill and equipment to repair someone's door. We will never be able to repay our loving God but we are able to use our gifts in God's service. May we be more faithful using our gifts so others may be nourished in God's love.

May our service inspire others.

Expectant and New Parents

If you have already been blessed with a new little one and you haven’t registered for the Baptism program, just call. You will be sent a letter with information about the process. For whatever reason, if your child is older and has never been baptized, guess what, just call.

Once you receive the letter, call to schedule the parent interview which should take place before the ‘Meet and Greet’ with other couples and members of the Baptism team.

PREP (Parish Religious Education Program)

You may still register your child for PREP. Please call the Religious Education Office at 215-357-3445. You can also access the registration forms on the webpage (*see directions below). If you have a child entering Grade 1 in public school, have recently moved into the parish, or if your child attends a private school and needs preparation for sacraments, please call the Religious Education Office for information about our program. We also offer a special class for older students who have not had prior religious education and need preparation for sacraments.

PREP DISMISSAL PROCEDURES: Sunday PREP students will be brought into the hall and seated at tables. Please do not block the stairs or landings—come into the hall to pick-up your children. If you are not staying for Mass, you may send a note in to the catechist and your child will be dismissed from the door closest to the field.

Monday PREP students will return to church. Parents are asked to enter Church quietly using the middle aisle, and exit down the side aisles.

PREP families are asked to donate a jar of peanut butter and/or jelly for our yearly collections. Donations are given to the Parish Food Pantry to benefit members of our parish family.

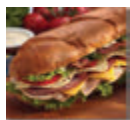

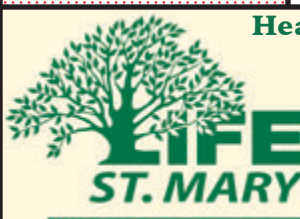
