From the Desk of Sister Diane

Ezekiel 17: 22-24; Ps. 92; 11 Cor. 5: 6-10; Mark 4: 26-34

This Sunday we listen to the parable of the Sower and the seed. Yesterday the June “Meet and Greet” gathering of new parents preparing for the Baptism of their children was held. And reflecting on that the Holy Spirit offers us a sequel to Jesus’ original parable. (You may need to reread Jesus’ parable from Mark first.)

The seed in this sequel parable is new life and the sowers are Mom, Dad and God. Throughout the pregnancy Mom and Dad sleep through the night as new life begins to grow in the womb seemingly of its own accord. No doubt parents like the farmer in Jesus’ parable ponder what is happening week to week through the nine months. And when this new life is ready to blossom the baby is born!!!!

Now what? For the farmer the tomatoes may be enjoyed at the next meal or the smell of fresh flowers might fill the air. Or perhaps the seed became a tree that will shelter others for years to come. For the most part the work of the farmer is done for this year’s harvest. But for the parents their effort/work is just beginning.

Back to the Baptism class where young parents considered what the commitment to having the baby baptized fully means. Are they ready to say ‘yes’ to the question, “Parents, do you understand what you are undertaking?” That ‘yes’ is a lifelong promise to be role models in the faith through prayer, love beyond family and friends, the good example of kindness, joy, simplicity, honesty, sacrifice and more. *Lifelong* is key. Not just until this ‘seed of new life’ starts Catholic school or PREP or until Confirmation. If the farmer watered the seeds until a first leaf sprouted and then stopped there would be no tomatoes to harvest. The faith journey of a child, like our own is never complete until we go home to God. The ‘yes’ must always remain active.

And so too, for all of us who have said ‘yes’ as parents, Godparents or sponsors. For a rich yearly harvest the ‘sowers’ must remain engaged. To be faithful to this commitment God is the sower that leads us.

The second half of the morning, experienced team parents share a glimpse of the journey ahead from their experience thus far. They speak of the joys and challenges with their children as well as the need for parents to continue their faith journey as couple and family. Role modeling is essential in forming a young disciple. Let us look to the master Sower for ways to nurture what the seed has produced.

These documents are available to volunteers for free. If you already have these clearances they need to be dated within the past 24 months.

If you've lived in another state in the last 10 years, you also need to do an FBI clearance, which is NOT free.

**A Letter from Most Reverend Charles J. Chaput
Archbishop of Philadelphia**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Next weekend our diocese will take the Peter's Pence Collection. This global collection supports the Holy Father as he reaches out in mercy and charity to people who are suffering. Your generosity will help Pope Francis ease the suffering of some of the most marginalized throughout the world and show them the tender love of God

Pope Francis challenges us to look at those around us with the eyes of mercy. He says, "We encounter so many weary and oppressed people today ...and how is our heart? Is it merciful? And our way of thinking and acting, is it inclusive?" (Jubilee Audience, Nov. 12, 2016). I invite you to reflect on how you feel moved to answer the call to mercy.

In Iraq, many people still live a nightmare of war and violence. This has left many displaced, including young people in the midst of their studies. Without an educated population, it will be difficult for the country to gain stability. But with the support of your diocese to the Peter's Pence Collection, the Archdiocese of Erbil, in Iraqi Kurdistan, has received funding for 10 scholarships for young displaced persons. With this help, the students can complete their university education and move forward with the hope of rebuilding their country.
