## **PARISH MISSION STATEMENT**

*As a parish community united in Jesus and dedicated to Mary,  
we are called to discipleship through worship and service.*

### **Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time** **February 17, 2019**



Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose hope is the Lord! (Jer:17:7)

Before continuing, ponder the depth of your trust, your hope in the Lord. Not to have things go your way but to believe that the Lord will answer your prayer. Is your (or my) relationship strong enough that when God's response seems to be delayed or different or not even answered, will I still trust?

On January 27th, Pope Francis celebrated the closing Mass for World Youth Day in Panama attended by hundreds of thousands of young people from 155 countries. He began, "My dear young people, you are not the future but the now of God and he invites you and calls you in your communities and cities to go out and find your grandparents and elders; to stand up and with them to speak out and realize the dream that the Lord has dreamed for you. Realize you have a mission to 'fall in love; that will decide everything', " as Fr. Pedro Arrupe, former Father General of the Jesuits, once said. Pope Francis told them that "Jesus was inviting each one present to join him in his 'mission' today, not tomorrow." The pope explained that "Jesus reveals the now of God, who comes to meet us and call us to take part in this mission today."

Pope Francis reminded the young, "We may possess everything but if we lack the passion of love we will have nothing". He appealed to them, "Let us allow the Lord to make us fall in love".

Pope Francis referred to the "Wake-up call" of drums and music they heard at 6 AM but that was nothing compared to the Pope's call to "allow the Lord to make them fall in love". Francis warned the youth against thinking that "your mission, your vocation, even your life itself, is a promise far off in the future, having nothing to do with the present. As if being young were a kind of waiting room, where we sit around until we are called." Addressing them directly as 'brothers and sisters', Francis declared, "The Lord and his mission are not a 'meantime' in our life, something temporary; they are our life!".

He urged them to follow the example of Mary, the mother of Jesus, "who not only believed in God and in his promises as something possible, she believed God himself and dared to say 'yes' to taking part in this now of the Lord. She felt she had a mission; she fell in love and that decided everything."

My challenge to each reader and myself is to determine how we can pass on the concept of "now of the Lord" to those who follow behind us, whatever the age. Obviously,, growing deeper in love with our God and being aware of the "Now" in each day. Not putting off or thinking I will have more time in the future. Today's invitation needs to be addressed now! And then we can be the elders those after us choose to follow.

May you fall deeper in love with Jesus in the "now" of each day!

Father Mike has made our parish the first in Bucks County to hold first Friday Night of Reparation. This night is a devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary which promotes the four pillars of the Catholic faith (CARE): confession, adoration, rosary, and the Eucharist. The next night of reparation will be celebrated at our parish on Friday, March 1st. The evening begins at 7:30 PM with confessions and rosaries followed by Mass at 8:30 PM, and goes through to 2:30 AM. Eucharistic Adoration and the divine office of the angels are prayed through the night. Mass to the Immaculate Heart of Mary begins at 12:00 midnight. Come and pray for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifference by which the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary are offended by the world.
