Pentecost Sunday— May 20, 2018

Acts 2:1-11; Ps.104: 1 Cor.12:3b-7,12-13;
John 2:19-23

“Filled with the Holy Spirit... speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God.”

Today we hear the awesome story of the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles signified by tongues of fire. Then, this group of previously frightened followers of Jesus began to speak in different tongues/languages as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Hearing the commotion, large crowds rushed to where the apostles were and became overcome with confusion as to what was occurring. Hearing the message of God and then realizing those in the crowd who spoke many different languages were also getting the message, must have left them dumbfounded in one sense. However, hearing the message of the ‘mighty acts of God’, what first left them bewildered turned into utter joy, excitement and enthusiasm.

From that day forward not just the apostles but the thousands of hearers returning to their hometowns, fueled with the power of the Holy Spirit, spread the word to every nation. As Paul tells the people in Corinth and today to us, “There are different kind of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit.”

And so, this is not a story just to retell but an experience to continue to spread in our daily lives through our words and work. Each of us, who have been blessed through the sacrament of Confirmation, are given gifts that make us responsible to do as the early Christians, spread the Word through sharing the Gospel in word but perhaps more importantly in action! Love is seen in what we do! What are our gifts? How are we called to use them? Often times you may come to a situation and think “I can’t do that” or “That’s not my gift”. In fact, the Holy Spirit may be inviting you to realize you do have that ability, if you trust the Spirit to lead you. Let us take time with the Lord in the days ahead to ponder what gifts we are called to use more fully at this stage of our lives.

May the gifts of the Holy Spirit lead us to new adventures!

Award Winning Dessert Recipe **Frozen Irish Mousse**

(6 servings)

Ingredients:

- 13 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup water
- 4 egg whites at room temperature
- 3 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup Irish Cream Liqueur, Bailey's
- 1 cup whipping cream, well chilled
- 1/2 cup whipping cream, beaten to stiff peaks
- Pinch of salt
- Pinch of cream of tartar
- Bittersweet chocolate shavings to garnish

Directions:

- Heat 13 tablespoons of sugar and 1/2 cup of water in a small, heavy saucepan, swirling until sugar dissolves.
- Increase heat and boil until syrup registers 240 degrees F on a candy thermometer.
- Beat egg whites with salt and cream of tartar until stiff but not dry. Beat in remaining 3 tablespoons of sugar, 1 tablespoon at a time.
- Pour boiling syrup into whites in a thin stream, beating until cool. This needs to be done slowly to avoid cooking the eggs.
- Add Irish cream liqueur and continue beating.
- Whip chilled cream to soft peaks.
- Fold whipped cream into meringue— Irish cream liqueur mixture.
- Spoon into parfait glasses and freeze at least 4 hours. (This recipe can be prepared the night before.)
- Just before serving, top each with whipped cream and chocolate shavings.
